BRIEF CURRICULUM VITAE

Nikoletta Tsitsanoudis-Mallidis is Professor of Linguistics and Greek Language at the Department of Early Childhood Education of the University of Ioannina. She is Associate in Linguistics at the Center for Hellenic Studies at Harvard University and a member of the Interdisciplinary Advisory Committee of the Center for Hellenic Studies (CHS/IAC) at the same university. She has been also a member of the Circle of Hellenic Academics in Boston. She has taught at undergraduate and postgraduate levels at the Universities of Ioannina and Thessaly, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Hellenic Open University, and as an invited professor at Boston University for a small number of lectures.

She has served as president and presenter at international and Greek conferences and as a reviewer for linguistic journals. Her studies have been published in Greek and international journals. She has been the academic coordinator of Greek language learning programs at the International Cultural Center "Stavros Niarchos" in Ioannina.

She is the author and/or editor of many books (19) in Greece and the United States, some of which are used as textbooks in university classes. Her latest book, $\Phi o \beta o \gamma \lambda \dot{\omega} \sigma \alpha / Pho \beta o glossa$, co-authored with Mr. N. Prevelakis, was included as a textbook in a course of the Modern Greek Studies Program at Boston University, as well as in a course at Macquarie University in Australia.

She received the "Distinguished Researcher" and "Distinguished Reviewer" awards in the United States from the Untested Ideas Research Center. In 2015, she was elected Executive President of International Academic Affairs of the Euro-American Women's Council (EAWC). She has been a visiting professor at the Harvard Olympia Program of Harvard University (Harvard Summer School, 2014) with a research scholarship.

She is the founder and scientific coordinator of the International Summer University "Greek Language, Culture, and Media," organized by the University of Ioannina with the support of the Center for Hellenic Studies (Greece) at Harvard, the European Parliament, and the Delegation of the European Commission in Greece, among others. The summer programs were under the auspices of the President of the Republic.

She has been the scientific coordinator of training programs for ERT journalists ("Short Language and Communication Seminars") and the Head of the Laboratory for the Study of Social Issues, Media, and Education of the Department of Early Childhood Education at the University of Ioannina. Today she is in charge of the "Greek Language, Culture and Media" unit of the same Laboratory.

Her latest monograph, "Greek Media Discourse from the reconstitution of democracy to the Memorandums of Understanding" was published by the Hellenic Studies Monograph Series of the CHS at Harvard University, following the assessment of the Publications Committee - Editorial Board of CHS at the University. It is distributed by Harvard University Press. Finally, she is Associate President of the Department of Early Childhood Education, School of Education, at the University of Ioannina. As a journalist, she worked for media in Athens and regional media. She occasionally

contributes articles to the press in Athens and the diaspora. She has been an organ donor since the age of 18. She is married to Mr. G. Mallidis and is the mother of two children.
